## God Cannot Be Separated From State

The separation of church and state is a fundamental premise of our Bill of Rights. The first amendment to our Constitution begins: "Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion, or prohibiting the free exercise thereof." However, no founding father ever envisioned a separation of God and state. To make this clear, government documents, from both the federal and state level, have long upheld the sovereignty of God over all the affairs of man. God and/or the Lord are mentioned in the constitutions of all fifty states. Here is a small sampling:

**The Declaration of Independence, July 4, 1776:** The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States of America, We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.

**Constitution of Georgia, 1777:** To perpetuate the principles of free government, insure justice to all, preserve peace, promote the interest and happiness of the citizen and of the family, and transmit to posterity the enjoyment of liberty, we the people of Georgia, relying upon the protection and guidance of Almighty God, do ordain and establish this Constitution.

**Constitution of Massachusetts, 1780:** We, therefore, the people of Massachusetts, acknowledging, with grateful hearts, the goodness of the great Legislator of the universe, in affording us, in the course of His providence, an opportunity, deliberately and peaceably, without fraud, violence or surprise, of entering into an original, explicit, and solemn compact with each other; and of forming a new constitution of civil government, for ourselves and posterity; and devoutly imploring His direction in so interesting a design, do agree upon, ordain and establish the following Declaration of Rights, and Frame of Government, as the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

**Constitution of California, 1879:** We, the People of the State of California, grateful to Almighty God for our freedom, in order to secure and perpetuate its blessings, do establish this Constitution.

**And of course ... Constitution of Oklahoma, 1907:** Invoking the guidance of Almighty God, in order to secure and perpetuate the blessing of liberty; to secure just and rightful government; to promote our mutual welfare and happiness, we, the people of the State of Oklahoma, do ordain and establish this Constitution.
