Elders, Deacons, Preachers, Teachers, Parents, Grandparents, Mentors... Have you prayed for your followers lately? Do the bulk of your prayers consist of things like keep them safe today, guide the hands of the surgeon, help them to find someone to sit with in the cafeteria today, prosper their business deals, help their house to sell, and on and on about earthly, temporal concerns? Our followers need spiritual leaders who understand that the spiritual is far more important than the physical. Notice what Paul prayed for the people of Ephesus in Ephesians 1:15f. *Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers; that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, ...* and in Ephesians 3:14f *For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith...* Where is his selfish prayer to be released from prison (remember this is where he was as he wrote this letter)? Instead he prayed for Christ's Spirit to strengthen the inner man and Christ to dwell in their hearts. Then James adds these words, "The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much, James 5:16b. If that is true – and it is – leaders can offer a resource that accomplishes much. Pray for those you lead, it is so powerful a leader can't lead effectively without it.
