"Here, We Learn Something!" — Part 2

The Benefits of Visual Aids

So how do we ensure our teaching is effective? One important tool is visual aids. Enhance memory. Visual aids do increase retention in our students. In fact, educational research tells us that if we hear a lesson on Sunday, we will remember only a small portion of that lesson on Wednesday. But if we hear and see the lesson, we will remember six times as much. Beyond stories and concepts, our students need to write God's Word on their hearts by memorizing Bible verses. Visualized verses are incredibly helpful. Find clip art or create WordArt for each word or phrase. Place the pieces on a magnetic board, and say the verse several times with the students while pointing to the pieces. Then remove one piece at a time – continuing to say the verse – until all the pieces have been removed. Even toddlers can learn complete verses and passage with this appealing learning tool.

Create interest. The right visual can also create instant interest in the lesson of the day. Imagine beginning a study of the conquest of Canaan by having a "monument" of 12 large stones in the classroom when the students enter. They will want to know what that pile of rocks is all about (Joshua 4:1-7). The visual generated an audience eager to hear God's Word – before the teacher ever said a word.

We teach our students that the Bible is real and that biblical events really happened. We tell them – but when we add visuals to our telling, the reality of biblical events and people comes alive for our students. Are you teaching about idols? Search the internet for a picture, and build a clay statue of the idol to take to class. Are the people in today's lesson taking a trip? Remember the map so your students can make the journey with them.

Illuminate difficult concepts. Visual aids enhance any Bible class, but they are

especially useful for teaching difficult concepts. Children sometimes have difficulty with the concept that the Lord's church is not the building, but the people. To help them see the difference, create letters out of light-colored paper at least 10 inches tall that spell "Church of Christ." Then, have all the members of the congregation sign their names on a letter; or take photos of each member, and print, cut and glue them to the letters. Cement the lesson in the students' minds by including them in preparing the letters. They might even meet members of the church they do not know.


