### Teach the Right Lesson

Because visual aids do make a tremendous difference in learning, retention and interest, we have to make sure they are teaching the right things the right way. Ask these questions about the visual aid you use:

- Is it scripturally accurate (e.g. are the animals bigger than Noah’s ark)?
- Will it teach the lesson God intended from today’s text (e.g. the feeding of the 5,000 was about the power of the Christ, not about sharing a lunch)?
- Does it employ a less-than-reverent approach to Scripture by using absurd cartoons, slang, etc.?

Remember that the power of visual aids can go both ways. Using them means students will learn faster and remember longer. But also consider that if the visuals give the wrong facts or impressions, our students will remember the wrong just as vividly and just as long as they could have remembered the right.

Visual aids are powerful tools in so many ways. But the greatest tool a teacher has is her own passion. A teacher who teaches because God’s Word burns in her bones – who simply cannot not teach (Jeremiah 20:9) – will be a significantly more successful knowledge-giver. Do you love the Lord passionately? Do you love His Word fervently? Let that love create in you a teacher who inspires her students to know God so effectively that anyone who sees her students exclaims, “In her class, they learn something!”

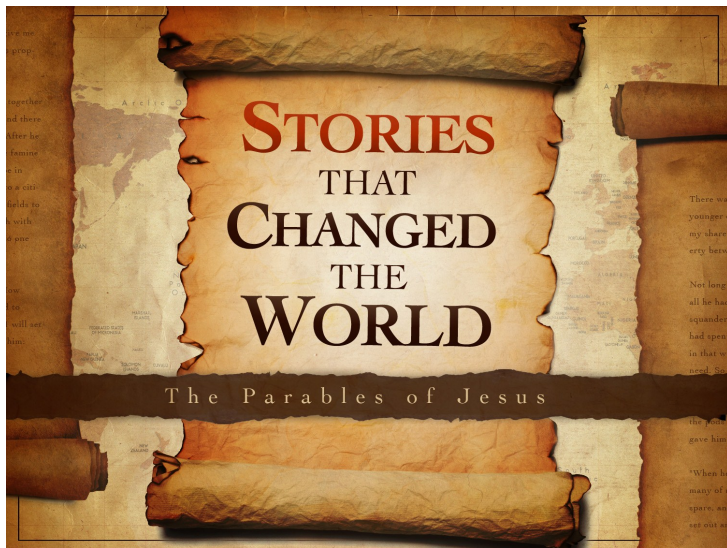
