Report on help for Mannford fire victims:

With the money donated to us for relief for fire victims we have been able to accomplish a lot in the community of Mannford. To date we have helped close to 30 people as they try to rebuild their lives. Here is a quick summary of what has been done.

- We have given away 25 \$100 gift cards to help families purchase the essential things that they need.
- We have also helped with \$250 worth of groceries and over \$100 in gas.
- One family was given money for a security deposit on a house, their electric bill was paid for, along with half of their rent.
- \$1070.37 was used to help repair 2 wells to provide water for a family.
- \$125.07 was used to purchase bedding and supplies for a family housing others in their home.
- \$294.95 was spent on Bibles to give to those who lost theirs in the fire.
- To date we have had \$20,849.92 donated and have spent \$5,842.03.

We are still working to help as many people as possible. We will be contacting those we have already helped to check on them and see if we can continue to assist them in any way. Most of those we have assisted were unable to tell us what all they needed because many did not have anywhere to live. In the next month many of them will be receiving trailers from the government and we will at that point be able to help them because they will have specific needs. Your prayers would be appreciated as we strive to reach out and not only help the people of Mannford physically but most importantly, spiritually. Thank you for your support in this work.
