O, For the Life of an Elder!

It is said that in the business world more and more of the executives are taking some "soothing lotion" for their ulcerated stomachs. The reasons given for this is labor management problems, keen competition, high overhead, etc. While our sympathy for our friends of the business world is in order, we wonder what would happen to them if they worked in the circumstances that most elders do in the church of Christ.

What would happen if they had to try to please two hundred people, yet knowing all the time that they must first please God? That they were never able to see all of their workers on the job at the same time? That a slight headache or "company" justified a worker taking a day off without letting them know? That rain or threatening weather kept a third of their workers at home? How would they feel if their workers only worked if they felt like it, and then (being kindly questioned about phases of their work), would immediately show their temper and threaten to quit? When slightly dissatisfied with some minor thing in the company, they would guit and become a member of some other company? That after they had committed themselves for several thousands of dollars worth of work during the year, only a few helped and stood by them? That their business was the largest in the world and yet it was financed only by free will offerings?

These things may be on the border of fantasy to our business men, but they are realities to elders in various congregations. It takes a very strong man spiritually and physically to be an elder of the Lord's church. Paul tells us how we can make their work easier: "Know them which labor among you, and are over you in the Lord and admonish you; and esteem them very highly
