When talking to people about the Bible and what it teaches, I've often heard people say, "I don't think it matters." Does it matter what the Bible teaches? Does it really matter what God says? These are important questions.

It mattered to Adam and Eve when they disbelieved God and believed Satan (Gen.3). It mattered to Esau when his father gave the blessing to Jacob (Gen 27:33). It mattered to Moses when he smote and spoke to the rock without authority (Num 20:10-11).

It mattered to Baalam when he tried to bless King Balak and curse the children of Israel (Joshua 13:22). It mattered to King Saul when he did not obey and destroy the Amalikites (1Sam 15:22). It mattered to David when he violated the fourth commandment and committed adultery (2Sam 12:1-7). It mattered to Uzzah when he steadied the Ark of the Covenant and violated God's specific command, even though it was done in ignorance (2 San 6:6-7). It mattered to Pharaoh when he would not let Israel go. It mattered to the ten northern tribes when they practiced idolatry and were carried away into captivity, never to return.

It mattered to the young prophet who stayed and ate when God had told him not to stay. It meant his death (1Kings 13:16-22). It mattered to the Jewish nation in the New Testament when they rejected Christ. It meant that God rejected them as his people (Matt 24:38).

To do the will of the Father is the key to acceptance, according to Jesus (Matt 7:21) the "obedience of faith" (Rom 1:5; 16:26). Don't let anyone convince you that what God says doesn't matter.

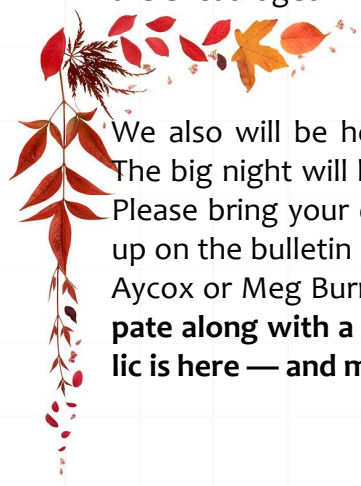

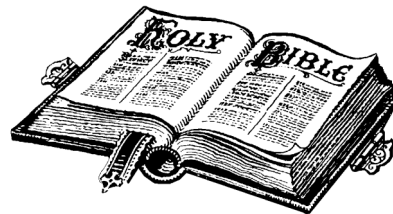
