# **Behavior that Fits the Name**

During the fourth century before the birth of Christ, Alexander the Great of Greece conquered the Mediterranean world. Though he did not realize it, God was using him to prepare the world for the coming of the messiah. As a result of his conquests, Greek was established as a common language throughout that part of the world, and it was so even in the time of the Roman Empire. The New Testament was written in Koine (common) Greek, the simplest and most readable form.

John Borgstrom writes about one of Alexander's campaigns, during which he received word that one of his officers had been continually and severely misbehaving. His actions shed a negative light on the character of all the Greek troops. What made the situation intolerable was that his officer's name was also Alexander.

Legend has it that when the commander heard about the behavior of this young man he sent a summons to have him appear before him. When the officer arrived at the tent, Alexander the Great asked him: "What is your name?" The reply came back: "Alexander, Sir." The Commander looked him straight in the eye and said forcefully, "Soldier, either change your behavior or change your name!"

Because you and I (and the church) wear the name of Christ, our attitudes, words and deeds cast a reflection on Him and on all His followers. Others will make a decision about the Lord based in part on

> what they see in our lives. Those who may not hear the ser mons we preach cannot miss the sermons we live. An old poem suggests that you and I are writing a gospel every day by the way we live. Then the poem asks, "Say, what is the gospel according to you?"

> If we are going to wear the name, let us be sure we bear the character of Jesus Christ that others see Him living in us.
