In the last several months, we have had opportunity as a church family to open our hearts and wallets to help people who faced great adversity. Here is an update on two of those efforts.

First, we have news from those recovering from Super Storm Sandy in New Jersey. We were able to send funds to the Gateway Church of Christ, a small church of about fifty people, started through a church plant in 2011. It meets at the Senior/Community Center in Holmdel, New Jersey. Gateway has worked to be active in the Bayshore area and surrounding communities in New Jersey to share the Gospel of Christ. Concerning the recovery efforts, they write: "Our work in the Bayshore Area has allowed us to encounter two groups of people: the volunteers and the people in need. With both groups we have an opportunity to share the gospel. Although we have spent the majority of our time these past months serving people's physical needs, we have also become a group to whom people have become willing to listen. Many in the community are recognizing the love of Jesus through Gateway and our sister churches who have helped in the relief efforts here."

Second, we have news from the town of West, Texas which recently suffered from a plant explosion. The New Road Church of Christ helped to coordinate efforts to help this town and the small congregation that meets there. Glenpool was one of many churches that sent money. In less than two weeks after the explosion, New Road leaders delivered \$125,000 in checks and gift cards to the West church. In a letter addressed to our own congregation, the New Road congregation writes: "We

would like to sincerely thank you for your generous donation to the West Church of Christ and the members of the West community. Your kind gift will be of great help during this time of tragedy and loss." As the minister at West, Ernie Albrecht, recently said in a Christian Chronicle article, "You realize there's faithful brethren that just want to do good. The brotherhood, for all the negative talk, is an amazing brotherhood."

"So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith." (Galatians 6:10)

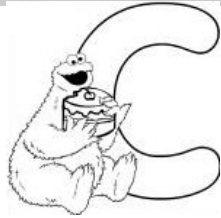
