Back to School Challenges!

Paul said he was an ambassador for Christ, and we have a responsibility to be the same (1 Cor. 11:1). Students, youth is no excuse not to be about our Father's business (Jer. 1:4-7). If Jesus is your Savior, then He is your Lord too (2 Peter 3:18). Act like it!
