As an eldership here at Glenpool we strive to provide the greatest atmosphere of Bible teaching and learning as is possible. this in mind, we begin a new Sunday evening program today that we hope will enhance our goals of producing the most spiritual knowledge, understanding, and encouragement of God's Word that is possible. We will begin our service with a “devotional type” worship including songs of praise, prayer, the Lord's Supper and a message from God's Word. Following this we will provide a period of Bible study and instruction for all ages. The adult class will be in the auditorium and be an informal Bible study where questions can be asked and discussed on the lessons provided. Our older young ladies will share in a class where they will be instructed on the role of women in the Church. They will discuss the conduct and attitudes of Christian ladies as well as learning how God wants women to serve in His Church. The young men will also receive instruction on the service they can render in the Church. There will be instruction on presenting God's Word in a lesson, directing congregational prayer, reading the scriptures, directing the song service and the mechanics of serving around the Lord's table during our communion service. The younger children will be placed in an environment where the Bible will be brought to them on their level through Bible stories, application lessons and Bible drills. We are very excited about this program and we want you to be excited also. Please give prayerful consideration to making this service a regular part of your week. We have excellent material and very competent teachers who have volunteered to direct this program. What we now need is you. Remember the spiritual potential for this program is eternal.
