Building Update

We are going to try to get in the habit of running a monthly update on our building program. The goal is to keep you informed and to prevent anxiety over the project's progress. If you have additional questions, feel free to ask, and I will do the best I can to get you an answer.

Why the long delay?

Vista Construction has always used the same subcontractor for metal erection. It is the same subcontractor who erected the metal for our current fellowship hall. However, the subcontractor ran into unexpected difficulties on the job previous to ours. He was very candid in telling Vista (who in turn told us) that there would be at least a four week delay in his starting date for our project. This is why there was no metal erection during most of the month of December.

Was the delay expensive?

No, not at all. We pay monthly invoices for work that is actually done. Neither Vista nor the subcontractor was paid during the period of delay. The project also has a guaranteed maximum cost that is agreed upon contractually, excluding change orders that come from us. Delays or other contractor issues do not affect that agreed upon maximum amount.

Has the total cost of the building changed any?

Yes, but not due to the delay. The city of Glenpool surprised us with additional fire safety and water retention requirements that necessitated additional dirt work, water lines, and plumbing. This was an expensive addition that was added as a change order to the maximum cost of the building. However, we do not believe that the amounts were so great as to impair the overall building program.

What is happening now?

During the delay, the plumber installed the additional water lines as required by the city. As it turns out, the metal erection could not have begun until this was finished anyway. As you can see, the metal is now going up and we hope the pace increases in the coming days. Once the metal frame is complete, the metal covering and roof will go on. The metal on the exterior walls will be covered by stone-type material later on, so do not be surprised if it doesn't look like you thought it would just yet.
