What is happening now?

Right now, as you can see, we are still waiting as the metal erection contractor finishes this phase of the building process. The work has been going slowly due to weather. As you know, we had the misfortune of a late start on the metal construction which pushed that work into the winter months. Next, we have had a fierce winter that has refused to let go. This was followed by lots of wind, which also creates delays in the metal erection process. The workers are dealing with large sheets of metal that practically become kites in wind speeds over 10-15 mph. All of this has combined to cause this phase of the process to drag out longer than expected.

However, we are happy that the metal work is progressing as well as in other areas. While the metal framework has been delayed, other crews have been able to continue their work, so that the overall project has not gotten any further behind. As you can see, windows have been installed, interior wall framing is nearing completion, and the fire suppression system is also essentially ready.

What is happening next?

In the coming weeks, we will start to see more work on the metal framing. We are hopeful to soon see the last phase, the metal roof. In addition, other crews will be working simultaneously. The electrical contractor will be pulling electrical lines through our existing building and preparing to tie into the new structure. Also, once the roof is finished, the baptistery will be installed. We are still a few weeks out from receiving our stone order, but once the metal work is finished, we will hopefully start to see the installation of the exterior stonework. That is when the shape and look of the building will really begin to show!

And after that?

Once the building is sealed up, there will be a long stretch of time this spring and summer where you will not see anything happening. The work will be going on inside, and for your safety, we will ask that you stay out of the construction area. However, we hope to take pictures throughout the process and keep you updated on how things are going, even when the work is hidden from view. After that, we will start looking forward to our grand opening — our first Sunday in our new auditorium! It is still way too early to give you a firm date, but we will have more information on that later on. Until then, keep praying for the work, the workers, the church, and the community of Glenpool!
