## Building Update

A lot has happened this summer. Let's catch up!

**New Sign Approved!** The elders recently approved the new sign for our building (shown here). The sign contains a LED screen on both signs for advertising upcoming events, special announcements, and times of worship.

### Why Are We Getting a New Sign?

In the next six weeks or so, the current driveway entrance will be expanded to include one entrance lane and two exit turn lanes. As a result, the existing sign will have to be dismantled. It seemed like a good time to look into a new sign, and the price fit our budget. The new sign will take the place of the yard signs that we use for VBS and other events, and it will take advantage of the considerable traffic up and down Elwood.

### What Is Happening Inside?

Mudding and taping continues on the sheetrock. Once that is finished, another crew will come in to install the grid for the ceiling. After that, we still have work to be done on paint, carpet, and plumbing, as well as finishing touches in a number of other areas.

### What Is Happening Outside?

The exterior is nearly complete. Gutters will need to be installed and some of the last pieces of trim. The major work is done, as evidenced by the removal of the construction fence. There is still some concrete work remaining, landscaping, and continued work on the Heat and Air.

### How Are We Doing Financially?

Even with a few surprises, we are still within the available resources intended for the project. Better yet, out of \$1,165,078 of total expected cost, the church expects to stay under our approved mortgage cap of \$615,000. That means that the congregation has funded around 47% of this project. Well done and praise God!

### So when do we move in?

That is the big question isn't it! We have a guess or two, but it is not fixed enough to make any kind of announcement at this time. As soon as we get something more solid and credible, we will be sure to let you know with lots of enthusiasm! However, it is never too early to start talking about the project to others and creating some excitement. Keep the church in your prayers as together we inch closer to the finish line.
