“Special Needs”: An Event on April 26

We are thrilled to announce a special event which we have scheduled for April 26. Tim Pyles, minister at the Broken Arrow Church of Christ, will be coming to visit and will be speaking on two very important and needed topics related to attending to those with special needs. Tim and his wife Kim have a special heart for this sort of ministry, as well as 22 years of experience raising their son, Coleman.



We will combine both adult classes so that everyone can hear this important material. Below are Tim’s descriptions of his lessons.

Class: “Room at the Table: Welcoming Families with Special Needs”

Most families with special needs children or adults are not in places of worship on Sundays. During the week, they deal with constant educational, medical, emotional, and financial struggles. Fearing that a visit to a church might prove to be just one more battleground fraught with stares, avoidance, and lack of understanding, they choose to stay home, deepening their isolation and intensifying their loneliness. There are many things that churches can do to cultivate an environment and communicate a message that special needs families are welcome and can find a safe haven and a community of love, support, encouragement, and assistance.

Sermon: “The Least of These: A Biblical Ethic for Special Needs Ministry” Matthew 25:31-40

God has always called his people to extend hearts of compassion and hands of mercy to those in need: strangers and foreigners, widows, the fatherless, and others whom our larger culture may neglect or marginalize. No one demonstrated that ethic more beautifully and consistently than Jesus, and He instructed His followers to follow in His steps in doing the same. Among those in our communities and congregations who desperately need those expressions of the Father’s love and the warm embrace of inclusion in a community of faith are children and adults with special needs and their families.
