After over a month of planning, gathering and sorting, we shared our personal “let’s get rid of this stuff” items with the families of Glenpool in our parking lot sale to benefit Hope Harbor Children’s Home. By counting each one who shared donated items along with the wonderful people who spent hours at the building sorting and hanging items, I believe more than half of our church family contributed to this effort. It was amazing! If this was not enough excitement, the day of the sale was incredible. Help began showing up between 5:30 and 6:15 am, ready to go to work. Every rack of clothing, every table of items and every stand-alone piece was in place by 7:00. This was a good thing since our 8:00 am starting time was preempted by 7:00 am shoppers. It was a work of love and compassion all day long. If anyone needed encouragement during the day it came from those who came to shop. I heard “thank you” from nearly everyone. A grandmother told me “this was a God-send” for her grandchildren. Another mom told me she was able to afford enough summer shirts to take care of all four of her children. She then said it couldn’t have happened without us. We had a sign up explaining what our sale was about and by mid afternoon, we had to unload our blue clothing box in the parking lot as it was overflowing with donations being brought by those who had attended our sale. By the 2:00 pm end of sale time we were all tired, sunburned and dragging but we knew we still had the huge task of re-boxing and storing all the items that didn’t sell. I heard not one grumpy remark but rather everyone grabbed a box and started loading items. We were also greatly encouraged by the half dozen people who came to help get this job done. Finally, around 3:30 or 4:00 pm our job was completed and all the boxes were stacked in the garage. As we sat in the fellowship hall catching our breath and getting a moment’s rest, we were informed that we had a great day financially, raising over \$1850 for Hope Harbor. Everyone was excited and then

someone said, “I wish we could have topped out at \$2000. That would have been even greater!” A moment passed and a voice said, “I’ll put in 20”. Another voice echoed the same thing. A third voice said “I’ll give \$100” and in about two minutes we had a total gift of over \$2000. What more can I say? You are such an awesome family!

Then to top off the weekend, we were blessed to have Tim Pyles come and share God’s message of compassion and mercy and it made the whole weekend fit. Thank you again for your commitment and love for the work of the church. We are so blessed to work with you.
