Brief History of Frog Road Christian Camp

My favorite week out of every year is Faith Week at Frog Road Christian Camp. It is the place where I met my wife, and the place where I did a lot of study and maturing as a young Christian. It is a place where I met friends and role-models who would become friends that I still have to this day.

The camp grounds were donated for the purpose of creating a camp in the mid-1970's. The metal building still in use today was constructed and the camp began operation. The camp facility is overseen by a Board of Trustees, and individual sessions are sponsored by various congregations. One long-standing session usually taking place in early June of each year was sponsored by several area congregations. Such men as Tom Bright, Jim Pinkston, and Randy Brown directed this session. Congregations from Sapulpa, Drumright, Cleveland, Glenpool, Muskogee, Prague, Okmulgee, Ramona, and Barnes (OKC) among others have participated through the years. In 2002, the Barnes congregation sponsored the session, under the direction of Johnny Hinton and myself. I said I would do it for just one year.

That was thirteen years ago.

This session came to be known as "Faith Week." Faith Week is unique for several reasons. First, it is not designed to be a session populated by children of only one congregation. The goal has always been to involve several smaller congregations. Sessions are small, independently directed, and inexpensive, all to the benefit of the camper. Second, Faith Week takes one book of the Bible and studies it for the entire week. In this way we can develop a specific faith-building theme from God's Word.

Every session at Frog Road Christian Camp is committed to the camper. This is not a vacation for anyone! It is a work week where we serve in the Lord's harvest fields, planting the seeds that will grow into Christians tomorrow.

Faith Week has never been a session that encouraged high pressure techniques. Baptisms are surprisingly rare at camp, but more often happen once campers have gone home and studied more with their parents. Our goal is to make the campers more spiritually minded, believing that this mindset will ultimately lead them to a mature conversion decision.
