In the twelfth chapter of John's Gospel, Jesus enters the city of Jerusalem amid large and cheering crowds. They had heard of the great teacher and miracle worker. They had heard of the man that rose up Lazarus from the grave. As he entered the city, people shouted blessings and called him the King of Israel.

I wonder how many of those people actually caught a glimpse of Jesus. How many came because of the commotion but never got close enough to see the man himself? How many might have joined the excited shouting but never set eyes upon the humble stranger riding into town on a donkey?

A few Greeks seemed to find themselves in exactly that situation. In John 12:20-21, the text tells us that a few Greeks had come to worship and apparently were aware of Jesus' arrival. However, they never got a glimpse of him, so they approached Philip and made a simple request, "We would see Jesus."

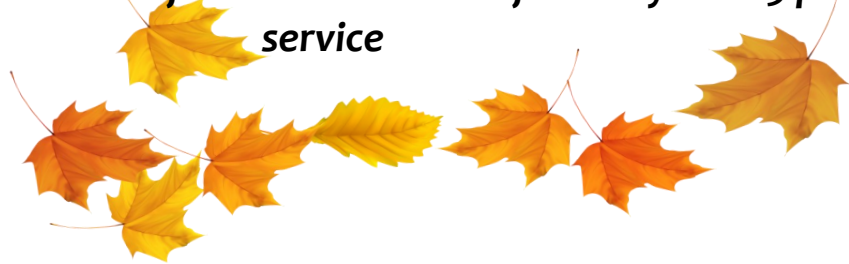


Welcome
