Wrapping Up Our Mark10 Program

This past school year we, as a congregation, started a meal program for children in the Kiefer school district. The Mark10 program was designed to help provide food for children over the weekend while they are away from school. These kids are already on a free and reduced lunch program at school and many go hungry over the weekend. Our goal was to fill that hunger. Through your generous donations of food and money we were able to provide 44 children with enough food to make it through the weekend. Every child received 8-9, kid friendly, food items. On average the cost of each sack of food was \$2. That's less than a McDonald's happy meal and lasted the children two FULL days! Thank you so much!

Sadly, this is a growing need. The Glenpool schools have a similar program but not enough food, so children had to be put on a waiting list. Then by the end of the school year, the school had lost some of their support.

This is an area where we as a congregation can make a huge impact. We would like to continue the Mark10 program and have enough support to help the Glenpool school starting this next school year. We will still be taking money donations through the summer months so that by the start of the school year we will be ready to purchase food. Just \$2 a week helps provide a sack of food for a child. Please consider this for the upcoming months and thank you so much for your support and donations this past school year!
