## Let's Use Visible Reminders

*There is a growing number of health-conscious folks who are discovering that wearing a pedometer helps them increase their level of daily exercise. This step-counting device is both a recorder and a motivator for them. Knowing how many steps they take per outing, encourages them to walk more.*

*One woman's goal was ten thousand steps a day. To accomplish her goal, she began parking farther away from her workplace, walking up the stairs instead of taking the elevator, and doing more active tasks around her office. Her visible pedometer reminded her of her daily need to produce a healthy lifestyle change.*

*Visible reminders have a place in our Christian walk as well. When God instructed the Israelites to keep His commands in their hearts (Deuteronomy 6:6, He also told them to make visible reminders of His Word: "You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates" (Deuteronomy 6:8-9).*

*The purpose was not for mere physical decoration but for spiritual deliverance: "Beware, lest you forget the Lord who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage" (Deuteronomy 6:12).*

*Writing the words of Scripture on a sticky note, a memory card, or a calendar can turn our focus toward the Lord throughout the day. These visible reminders will encourage our steps of obedience to Him (Romans 6:17).*

*Let's memorize a verse of Scripture as we go to work this week by writing it on a card, taping it where it is visible, and meditating on that verse during the day. Habitually placing verses of Scripture into our subconscious mind will produce not only an increase in Bible knowledge (Deuteronomy 6:6; Proverbs 2:1-6; Proverbs 4:20-21), but will keep us from sin and sinful habits (Psalm 119:11; Psalm 119:98; cf. Psalm 37:31; Psalm 40:8; Hebrews 5:14).*

*Singing the words of Scripture-based psalms, hymns of praise, and spiritual songs while commuting to work, will also help us in keeping the holy Scriptures fresh in our mind (Colossians 3:16; Ephesians 5:19).*

### Jeff Lovitt—Biography

Converted to Christ in 1977 through the influence of Paula Bacon, then girlfriend (now wife of 39 years) while a Technical Drafting and Design student at Oklahoma State Tech. Married Paula, June 10, 1978. They have two grown children, Drew and Hayley. After working as a draftsman for an engineering company in the oil industry in Tulsa, Oklahoma, Jeff went to Harding University, where he graduated in 1981 from their two-year preachers' training program. Jeff began full-time ministry as the youth and college campus minister for the Charlotte Avenue church of Christ in Rock Hill, SC (1981-1985). He served as pulpit minister/evangelist for churches in Missouri and Oklahoma. He earned his bachelor's degree in Bible from Abilene Christian University in 1997 before returning to the Carolinas in 1998, where he first served as the pulpit minister/evangelist for the Biltmore congregation in Asheville, and has now been serving the Morganton church of Christ, since July 2001. He is the inventor of the educational game Babyopoly, which has been part of the national curriculum of the National 4H Club and used throughout the country to teach young people to postpone sexual activity and get an education before getting married. He has spoken in youth rallies, college retreats, and gospel meetings in Missouri, Oklahoma, and North Carolina. He has done mission work in England, Toronto, Ontario Canada, and Haiti. And Jeff has been a contributor to the Carolina Christian, the Carolina Messenger, and Daybreak magazines.
