GROWTH

Citing the tremendous growth our congregation has experienced in the last four years, last Sunday, the elders laid out an ambitious growth plan for our congregation that includes: connecting to city sewer system, paving a new parking lot, modifying the building to gain three additional classrooms, and to paying off what we owe on the bus.

They estimated the cost of this plan to be about \$150,000 and asked the congregation to help in two ways: First, for members to be prepared on October 29th, during our 5th Sunday Special Contribution, to give with our immediate growth needs in mind. Secondly, for every family unit within the congregation to anonymously complete a five-year pledge card and drop it in the collection plate during the special contribution on October 29th. This information will greatly help our elders in their planning. If you did not

receive a pledge card, they are available in the lobby.
