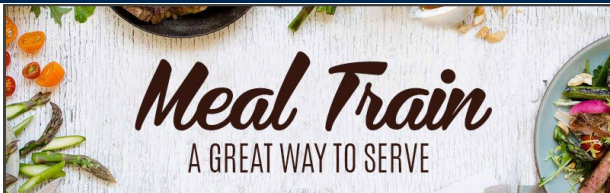

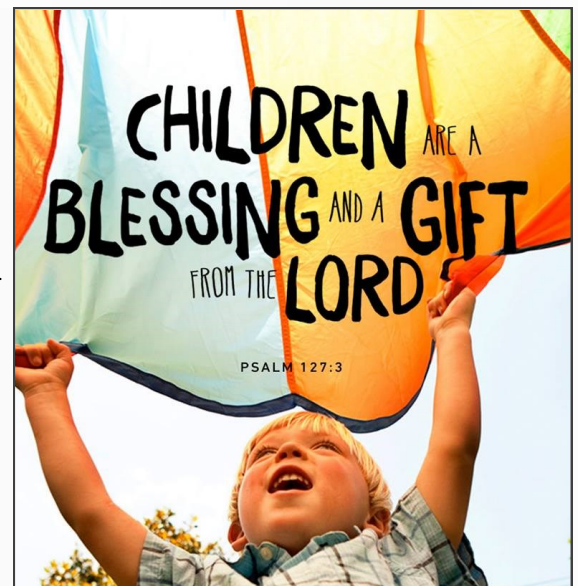

ATTENDED NURSERY
