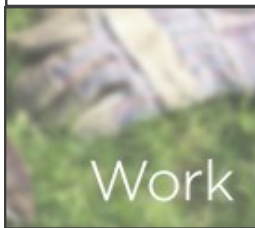

CAMP WORK DAYS

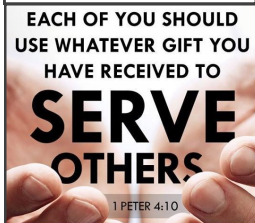
