- Please start saving paper towel rolls and toilet paper rolls for some of our crafts.



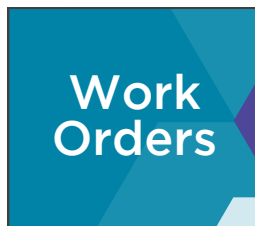
### SUNDAY SERVICE NIGHTS
