Our Mark 10 Backpack Food Program continues to be a big success. This outreach program began in 2015 serving 35 children from Kiefer Schools. In 2016 we added 25 children from Glenpool. The need continues to grow and we have at least 45 children from Kiefer who need assistance, which totals 70 children. This DOUBLES our numbers! I have witnessed the faces of these children when they receive their bags of food for the weekend and they are always grateful and always say thank you. I even had a little boy last year stop me in the hall and ask me if I realized we were out of school on Friday because he wanted to be sure he received his backpack food. That was a very humbling experience!

I want to thank each one of you who have donated to Mark 10. Selene has done a fantastic job purchasing the food items needed and stretched your dollars to furnish these children with 8 to 10 nutritious food items each week which meet nutritional guidelines used in schools. Here are a few items they receive each week: oatmeal, cereal, fruit cups, mac & cheese, ravioli, granola bars, raisins, fruit juice, etc.
