## NEWS & NOTES FROM BEN

It has been a privilege to participate in our New Song Class on the first Sunday night of every month. Singing has a rich history in churches of Christ. The songs you know today were once taught as new hymns in the singing classes of yesteryear. In the 1920s, Churches of Christ emphasized marching tunes and older spirituals. Sunday afternoon singings became very popular.

In the 1940s, many congregations attempted to make the worship assembly more stately. They appointed worship committees to create the order of worship still used in many of our churches today. The lively Stamps-Baxter hymns became unpopular in favor of more solemn hymns.

In the 1970s, another shift took place when livelier hymns came back into fashion. Notably, Alton Howard published *Songs of the Church* in 1971 featuring many of the now "retro" Stamps-Baxter hymns, bringing them back to popularity. "Father Along" and "Victory in Jesus" were often heard.

In the following decades, church song selection in our fellowship ebbed and flowed with the times. "How Great Thou Art" became immensely popular in Churches of Christ, but it started out as a theme song of the Billy Graham crusades. Songs popular in youth camps came to the forefront, like "The Steadfast Love of the Lord" and "Blue Skies and Rainbows."

Today, we continue to enrich our service with hymns, new and old. In the last year, we've learned seventeen new songs, listed below. We hope you continue to participate in our worship to God in song and join the happy chorus of Christian history in learning new hymns to God Almighty.
