NEWS & NOTES FROM BEN

I have never believed in "change for change sake." But neither do I believe in tradition for tradition sake. I think in everything we do, we must expect excellence and purpose. Why are we doing what we do, and are we doing it the best we can? Or as Paul says it, "Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men" (Colossians 3:23).

To that end, I've been taking a look at worship services on Sunday morning, specifically our order of worship and format. Some of us have noticed a few small areas of possible improvement which we believe will help us meet our goal of worshipping God "in spirit and in truth" (John 4:24). Our guiding question has been: How can we improve the service for all the generations of members present—young and old—without ignoring the primary goal of glorifying God as he has instructed us to do?

The elders have given permission for me to work with our deacons involved in worship in order to make some small scale changes for a short period of time for evaluation. I promise that these are really "small" changes, not a Trojan horse for changing any of our convictions about worship here at the Glenpool Church of Christ. We are talking about little details like when prayers are led, arrangement and selection of songs, how and when announcements are given, and such like.

In the month of February, we will enact these small changes and see how it goes. We ask for your patience and charitable spirit as we work it out. We also ask for your feedback, as we really want this to be an improvement for as many worshippers as possible. Nothing is set in stone, and nothing is irreversible.

Additionally, we do not believe that any one of us has "all wisdom" to make our worship as edifying, uplifting, and God-honoring as possible. While we ask for your patience during February's little experiment, we also seek your input. What does the best possible worship assembly look like for you? What keeps our worship from being the best it could be? Whose needs are we overlooking? We know that it is simply impossible to make everyone "happy," and so that isn't our goal. But if there is something we can consider which will help the whole body of believers, I want to hear about it.

Pray about this, brethren.
