

#### **NEWS & NOTES FROM BEN**

As I mentioned in the bulletin last week, we will attempt a few small changes to the order of worship this morning. February will be a time for experimenting to see how it all works out. Here are a few explanations of what is coming up today.

First, every worship service will begin with a Call to Worship. We will stand and sing a familiar hymn, "The Steadfast Love of the Lord." We will read a worship-themed psalm, and then pray to God to receive our worship. At that time, we will all be seated and our song leader will take the pulpit. Our first hymn each week will be a traditional hymn of praise to direct our worship to God and glorify him. Our second hymn will be a song about the story of the gospel. These two ideas—the greatness of God and the gospel of Christ—will be the bedrock on which our worship will be built.

Before our communion service, the song leader will sing a single verse from a communion hymn, quieting the service in preparation for the Lord's Table. As before, the communion will be offered with one man leading a very brief thought and the associated blessings of the emblems. At the end of our communion and as the servers return to the front, the song leader will lead us in "Doxology," a traditional hymn thanking God for his many blessings. Another man will lead us in a prayer for the contribution and collection. Following the communion and collection, we will sing a medley of songs in quick succession. This will be a combination of older and newer songs, all upbeat and joyfully worshipping God. Next, we will sing our "Theme Hymn." This song will be sung each week before the sermon, as it will directly relate to the current sermon series. Finally, we will sing one verse of a slower, devotional hymn ("Take Time to Be Holy") to prepare our minds for the sermon. This will be followed by a Scripture reading, sermon, and invitation.

Finally, we will end our worship with a hymn of sweet fellowship and prayer to God. At that time, an elder will give us updates on church activities, our sick, and other needs. He will lead us in a closing prayer and dismiss us. Afterwards, we encourage you to seek out the people on our prayer list, look for first time guests, and spend time in fellowship before heading off to lunch. Be friendly, not rushed!

Not all of the songs each week are in the hymnal, so large print weekly hymn booklets will also be available in the sound booth if you are unable to read the projection screens.
