NEWS & NOTES FROM BEN

Perhaps Spring has finally arrived! As the weather improves and the year rolls on, we have lots of opportunities for every member to get involved here at the Glenpool Church of Christ.

Frog Road Camp: My favorite week of the year is our camp session in early June. Faith Week at Frog Road Christian Camp will be hosting its 17th session since Selene and I started running the program in 2003. One of the big projects this congregation supports each year is the Spring maintenance and mowing out at the camp. I'll be making my first trip out to camp to survey what needs to be done on March 23. After that, we will need to schedule regular mowing trips. I'd like to invite our volunteers to join us (with their favorite mowing equipment, of course!) on the mornings of *April 6, April 27, May 18,* and *June 8*. If you have any camp related questions, let me know.

For children aged 10-18 and their parents, be aware that the Faith Week application is currently available online for you to fill out. Applications are due by May 16. The camper fee this year is still \$100 per camper. If you need any financial assistance, please let me know. We always have folks who would be willing to help sponsor your child. No one is ever turned away from camp over money issues.

EPIC Charter School: Our church has an incredible opportunity to interact with hundreds of school aged kids. In the month of April we will be allowing EPIC Charter Schools to rent the use of our facilities during the week for their end-of-year testing. Over the course of the month, our building will see approximately 600 kids and their families as well as 55 teachers. Students will come in on a rotating schedule. This is a great opportunity for these students and their families to know we are here. We will need to have a church member on site from 8 am to 5 pm each weekday, just in case any unexpected issues arise. The office staff will cover the morning shift without any problem, but we are looking for a few volunteers to help be on site in the afternoons (Noon-5 PM) so that I can run afternoon errands as needed, like picking up my son from school at 3 PM. If you are able to assist by spending some time at the building during the week, please let the office know. There will also be a sign-up sheet on the bulletin board.
