NEWS & NOTES FROM BEN

Summer is almost here, and students and teachers are glad for it! Let's take a moment and talk about what is coming up this summer and how you can be involved.

- Burnt Cabin (June 2--8):** After the fire at Frog Road Camp, we quickly had to find an alternative for our campers for this summer. Our friends at the Broken Arrow Church of Christ have room for us at their session this year, June 2-8, and we are excited to have our kids participate. You can fill out the application online (goo.gl/M71wRb) or mail in a paper copy from the table by the office. Either way, fees and applications are due May 22nd. This session will fill up fast, so don't delay. If you plan to go, PLEASE inform the office ASAP so we have an idea of how many are headed to Burnt Cabin. Once we get a good head count, we can discuss whether we need to take the bus out to deliver kids and their luggage, etc.
- Camper Donations:** One draw back to changing camp weeks is cost. Our session at Frog Road was only \$100 per kid, the cheapest rate in the state by far. In contrast, the Burnt Cabin session we will be attending this year is \$205 per kid. To help parents who are sending kids to camp, the church is taking up donations to offset at least half the cost of that fee, so that families only are responsible for the cost they originally planned to pay. If you are willing to make a donation, please pass that along to the office. Parents, if you need additional financial help, let us know. No child will miss out on camp this summer due to financial concerns.
- Vacation Bible School:** Looking further ahead, our annual Vacation Bible School will be in the evenings of July 24-26. Our theme is the life of Joseph, and our teachers are already getting excited about Egypt, coats of many colors, and all Joseph's fascinating dreams. An enrollment form will be available for kids in the month of June, so stay tuned for that.
