LETTER FROM THE ELDERS

Dear Church Family,

The elders realize that Ben's announcement at the end of services last week probably came as a great shock to everyone in the congregation. We ourselves were only informed of his resignation one week prior. Selfishly, we would like for him to remain right here at Glenpool, but we recognize that the Lord has even greater plans for Ben Williams and for his continued service in the Kingdom elsewhere. Our initial shock and disbelief, though, has slowly given way to gratitude and heartfelt support for Ben and his wonderful family. The elders are extremely grateful for the time the Lord has allowed him to minister to our congregation.

Almost 10 years ago, the Glenpool Church of Christ hired Benjamin Williams to the position of Pulpit Minister. At that time, a close-knit and authentic community of believers sought a preacher and teacher to help them grow the church. In the next decade, the Williams family and the church grew together and flourished alike in accordance with our understanding of God's plans:

- As our buildings improved and enlarged, Ben became more polished and articulate in delivering God's word to members and visitors here.
- Our reputation within the community grew in direct relation to Selene's focused efforts on the Mark 10 out-reach program.
