## **THE QUALITIES OF AN EFFECTIVE MINISTER**

Nothing is beyond God's ability, and it is up to us to ask in faith for his assistance and guidance. This week, I ask you to focus your thoughts and prayers on seven more qualities of an effective minister, and be asking God to lead us to such a well-rounded minister:

22. **Teaching Ability:** If you ask the average minister what their congregation expects from them, this will likely be one of their first responses. Churches look to their ministers to help them understand the Bible's application to their everyday life. A minister isn't expected to be a world-renowned expositor; he is simply expected to communicate biblical truths in a way that people can understand and benefit from.
23. **Love of Congregation:** A good minister is able to communicate his love for his congregation—even for those members who tend to be a bit prickly and unlovable. When love is genuinely exhibited within a congregation, everything else falls into place—most problems seem to fade away.
24. **Ability to Build a Team:** A minister is caring for a community of believers who need to be equipped for evangelism. Congregations want ministers who equip, delegate, and empower them to share the Gospel. So, a good minister isn't a loner isolated from the flock, but rather, leads and ministers from the middle of the pack.
25. **Disciple-Building Focus:** Churches want to see maturity happening in the lives of all attendees. They want to understand their church's process for turning a convert into a committed disciple of Jesus. A good minister should be able to focus on and clearly define a process that ensures spiritual maturity is occurring.
26. **Healthy Family Life:** If a minister's marriage is weak, his ministry effectiveness will suffer. While ministers are not always to blame for marriage troubles, church members desire a model of a godly marriage that they can emulate.
27. **Self-Awareness:** No minister is without weakness, and a good one knows this. Churches don't expect their minister to be perfect, but they do want him to be aware of and able to compensate for his weaknesses. If he can't do something well, he should delegate it to someone who can. If he is particularly vulnerable to a specific temptation, he should know how to avoid it.
28. **Spiritual Depth:** None of the traits listed above are of any value unless the potential minister has a fervent and thriving relationship with Christ. If we want church members to be fully devoted disciples of Christ, the minister must lead the way. Spiritual disciplines such as prayer and Bible study are a must for ministers. Indicators of spiritual immaturity are red flags in any serious ministerial search process.
