**MESSAGE FROM THE ELDERS**

As restrictions on worship and social gatherings are being lifted, the decision has been made to begin Sunday morning services on Sunday, May 17th. If cases happen to spike during the week of May 10th, the elders will revisit the decision to open.

The health and safety of all of you is of the utmost importance to us. With that in mind, here are the guidelines, suggestions, and modifications for May 17th. These will remain in place until further notice. We will regularly evaluate our situation and phase in other activities when appropriate.

- At 10:15am we will have a short devotional and singing for our youth (all ages). This will replace the Facebook lessons and singing from the past several weeks.
- Worship service will begin at 10:30am. Please move into the auditorium as you arrive to allow room for others to enter the building. As you enter, please be mindful of the youth devotional taking place.
- At the conclusion of our worship service, we will exit by row starting at the back of the auditorium to maintain physical distancing guidelines.
- There will be no classes or attended nursery.
- Individual communion packets will be available as you enter the auditorium.
- A place to drop off your contribution will be placed at the back of the auditorium rather than being passed during the service.
- Family members from same household may sit together. At least 4 empty chairs should be left between each family. Every other row will be removed to maintain proper spacing between rows.
- Please maintain at least 6 feet of physical distance as often as possible.
- High-touch surfaces such as doorknobs, light switches, bathrooms, etc. will be sanitized prior to and following the service.
- No Sunday evening service until further notice.
- Online Wed devotional will continue until we return to the building on Wednesdays. →
