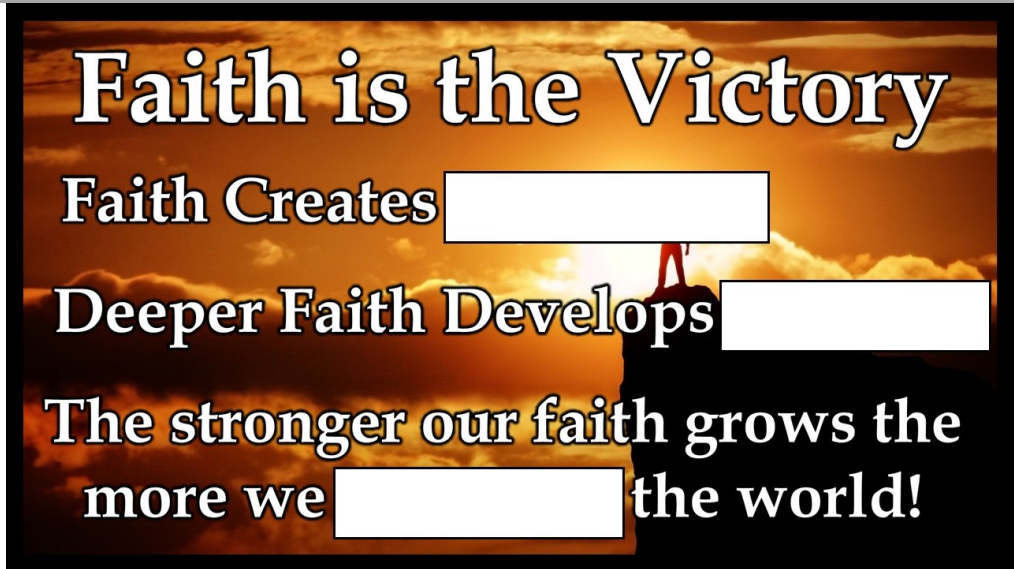

This past May we took up a special 5th Sunday collection for parking lot repairs. As always, the congregation was very generous, giving a total of \$2,826.50. So far we have four bids for the parking lot improvements ranging from:

- \$5,000 for seal coating and re-stripping the parking areas south & west of the auditorium.
- \$16,000 for seal coating, filling cracks and re-stripping the entire parking lot.
- \$73,000 for new asphalt and re-stripping the entire parking lot.

Repairs are on hold for the moment while several factors including fluctuating prices for materials & services, and the overall needs of the congregation are taken into account.
